

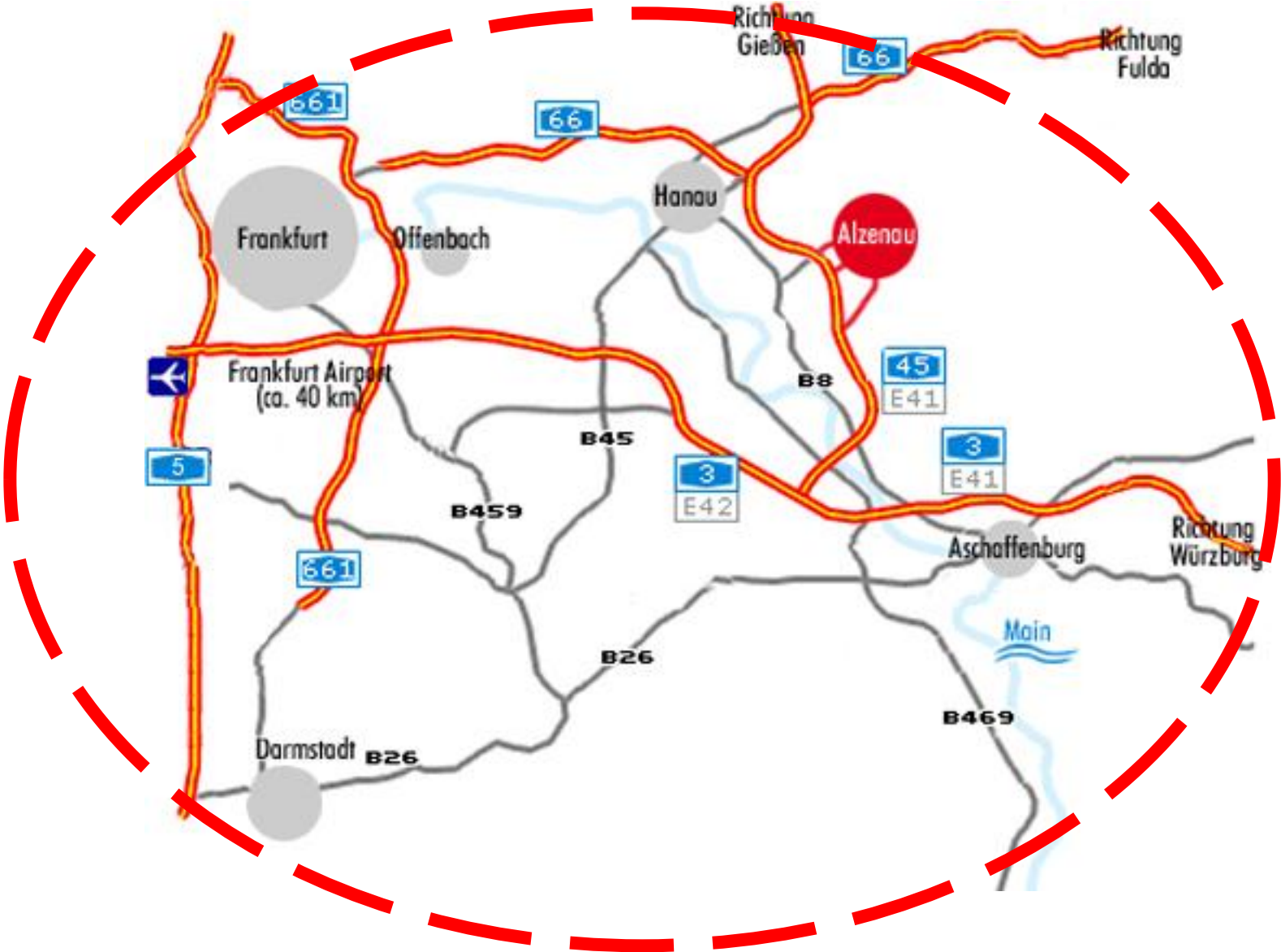

in 1994

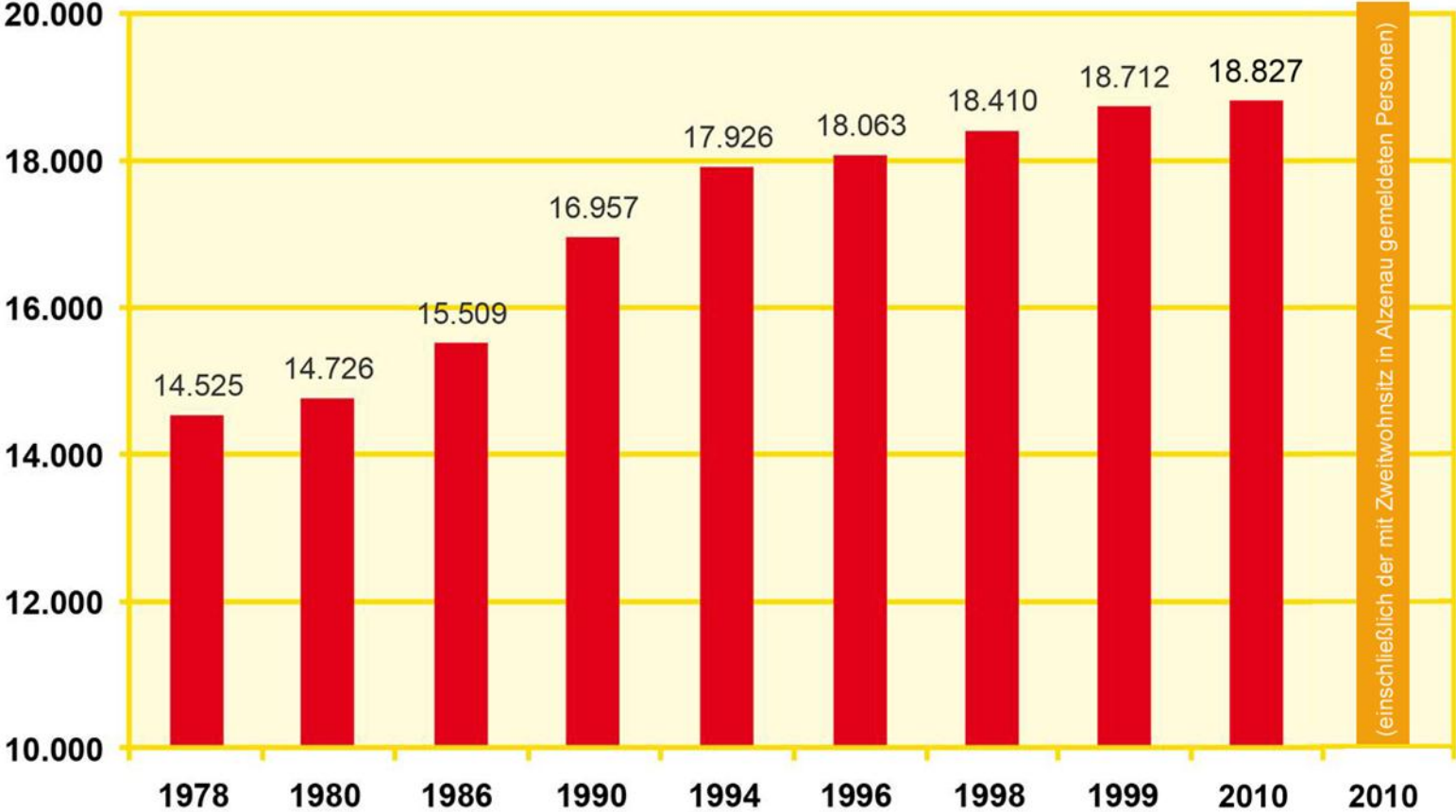
Pair of anniversaries in 2001:

- One of the lowest crime rates; one of the highest clear-up rates



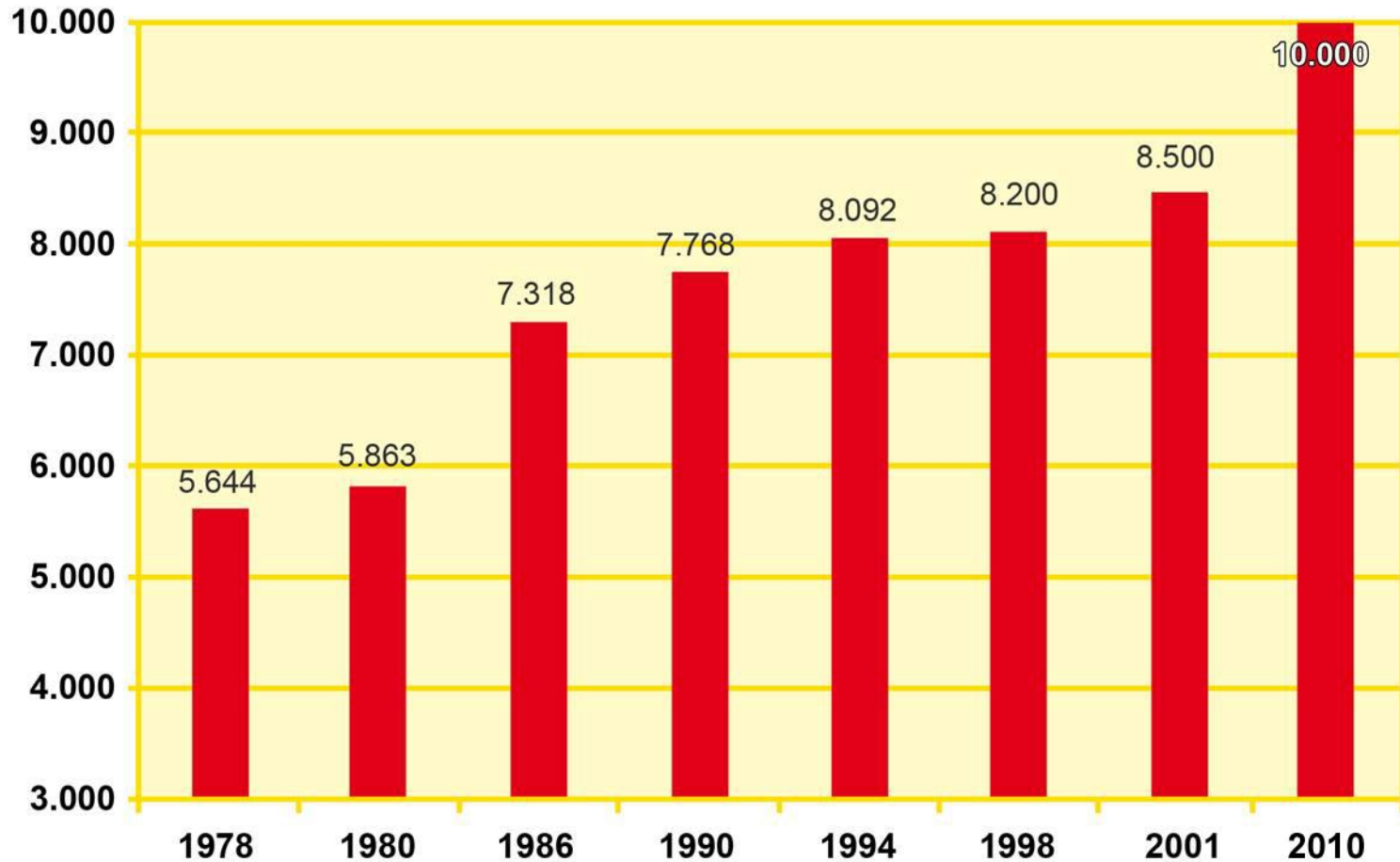

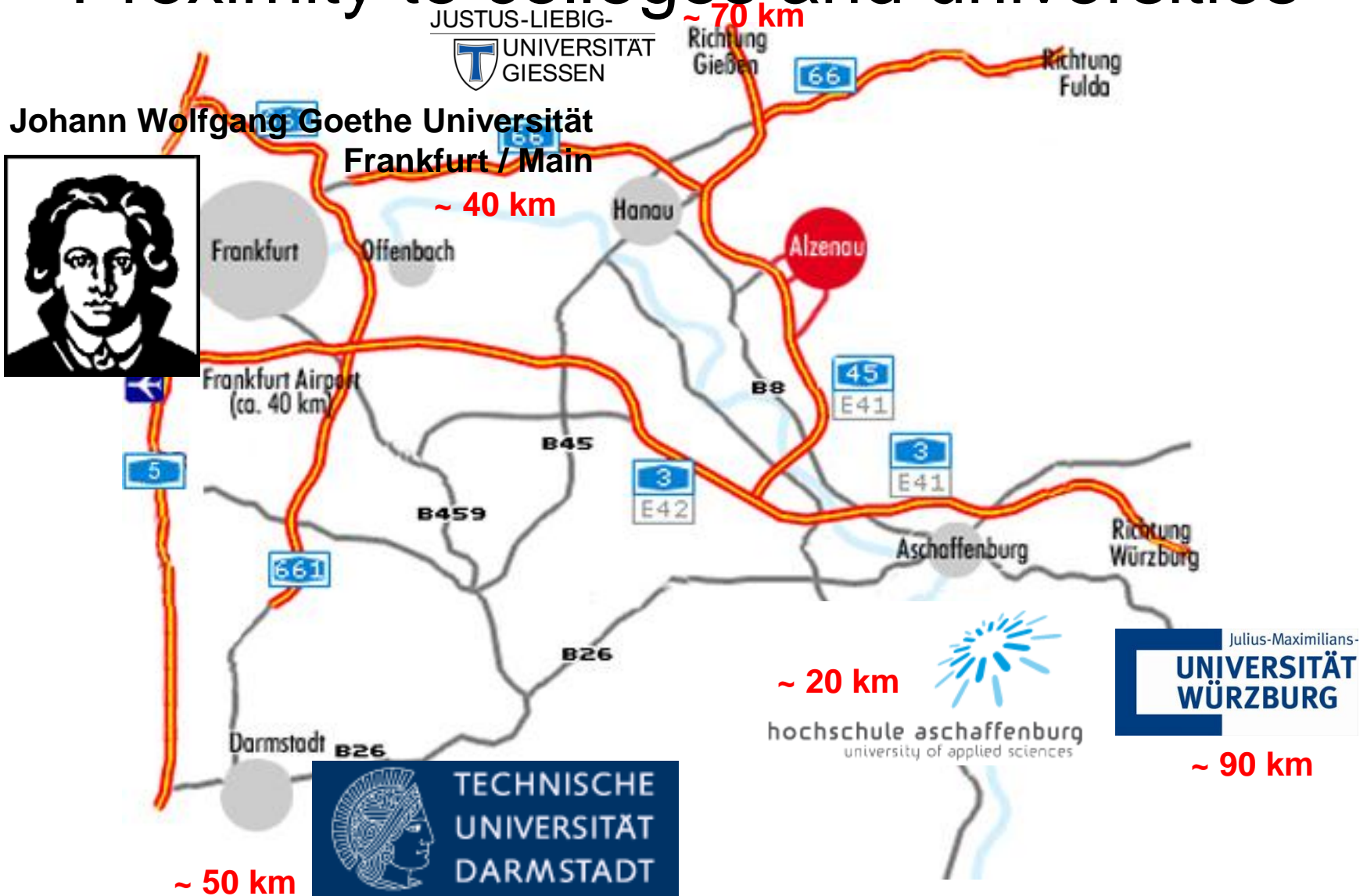
